Who does it apply to? CRIMINAL

All states and all citizens.

Sexual harassment and sexual misconduct as defined by Title IX and institutional policies. What is the scope of conduct?

Conduct as defined by the state's criminal statutes.

Violating the institution's policy against sexual harassment and sexual misconduct.

What is someone accused of?

Violating the state's criminal statutes relating to sexual assault, stalking, domestic violence, and harassment

Provide support and assistance to the complainant. Community Safety. Addressing the conduct, remedying its effects, and preventing its recurrence.

What are the goals?

Community safety and maintenance of norms, punishment, and/or retribution.

Resolutions, remedies and sanctions.

What are the outcomes?

Verdicts, sentencing and restitution.
